1. See if you can identify the division and classification of your favorite daffodils. (There are hints in the other daily daffs)
2. On a sunny day, take a walk or drive around your neighborhood. On your way, take some pictures of the daffodils that you see. How many different types of daffodils can you find?
3. What is another name for Daffodil? What is the Latin name?

5. Be smart. Learn to identify the parts of a daffodil. Find out more at <http://www.daffodilusa.org/>.
6. See how many words you can create from the letters in the word "daffodil."

8. Try writing a Haiku- 3 lines- 5-7-5 syllables per line for a total of 17. Here's an example:  
Daffodils spring forth  
Like sentinels in a row  
Facing the sunrise
9. Post your daffodil photos in the virtual daffodil show posted on this page. See if you can identify which division to post it in.
10. Write a story about a daffodil.
11. Starting in late March, take the "Daffodil Drive" along Eola Hills Road from Skyline Drive to SE Hood View Road to view the 700 new bulbs planted this year.
